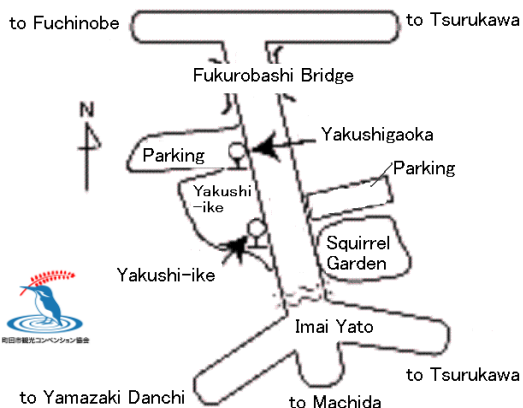

### Flower Calendar

Ume(Japanese Apricot)	Late February – Late March	White:175, Red:75
Sakura(Cherry Blossom)	Early April – Late April	Someiyoshino, Shidarezakura, Yamazakura, Satozakura, and Hikanzakura
Fuji (wisteria)	Late April – Early May	Most popular view is the Great Wisteria Trellis in the Dejima section – Sanjaku Fuji and Dharma Fuji
Japanese Iris	Late May – Late June	2,200 flowers (Higo:65, Edo:79, Ise:18, wild, etc.)
Snowball	Early June – Early July	1,800 flowers (50 types)
Ohga Lotus	Late July – Late August	Lotus from more than 2000 years ago, revived by Dr. Ohga.
Camelia	September – May	Best seen in March-May, 1,100 trees, 410 types
Leaf Foliage	Autumn	Momiji, Nishikigi, Sakura, etc.

### Access

- **FROM MACHIDA STA.** From bus stop #21 in front of the Pop Building, take "Honmachida keiyu Tsurukawa eki iki" (to Tsurukawa Sta. via Honmachida), or "Nozuta shako iki" (to Nozutashako) and disembark at "Yakushi-ike".
- **From Tsurukawa Station (Odakyu Line)**  
Take a bus "Honmachida keiyu Machida iki" (to Machida Sta. via Honmachida) and disembark at "Yakushiike". You cannot miss it.
